SUBJECT: Instructions for recovering Federal Excise tax on unused influenza vaccine

ALL STATE AGENCIES AND OTHERS AUTHORIZED TO USE STATE CONTRACTS:

Unused Influenza vaccine's can be returned for a full credit of the Federal Excise Tax (FET) only. No credit will be given for the vaccine only the FET will be credited.

- For multi-dose vials containing 10-doses, the refund amount would be \$7.50 per vial.
- For packages of 10 single-dose syringes, the refund amount would be \$7.50 per package.
- For packages of 5 single-dose syringes, the refund amount would be \$3.75 per package.

Policy and Procedure for Return of Fluvirin® Vaccine for Federal Excise Tax Credit

Effective July 1, 2005, all trivalent vaccines against influenza were added to Internal Revenue Code Section 4132(a)(1), which defines all taxable vaccines for the purposes of collecting a Federal Excise Tax (FET) to be paid to the National Vaccine Injury Compensation Fund.

Purchasers of Fluvirin ® (Fluvirin 5ml multi-dose vial) paid a \$0.75 per dose FET and are eligible for a credit of the \$0.75 per dose FET for unused doses that are returned. See below table for the FET refund eligible products and the applicable return window.

65521-0111-10 June 30, 2011

All products returned outside of these windows will not be eligible for Federal Excise Tax credit.

Due to specific IRS guidelines for required documentation needed to file for FET credit, only product returned through our 3rd Party Vendor will be eligible for FET credit.

2. Name and address of manufacturer or wholesale distributor from which product was acquired.
3. Date of return.
4. Product name.

8. Statement that returned product is “not for resale”.
9. (Optional) Customer Reference # / Unique Identifier for the return (e.g. PO number, Debit Memo # etc).

SUBJECT: IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION REGARDING INFLUENZA VACCINE 25 G x 5/8 SYRINGE

TO ALL STATE AGENCIES AND OTHERS AUTHORIZED TO USE STATE CONTRACTS:

OGS has received an important notification from both the manufacturer, Novartis Vaccines and Diagnostics and MMCAP regarding the needle length for Fluvirin Pre Filled Syringes (Item #2) for patient populations. It is MMCAP's understanding that the permanently attached 25 G x5/8" staked needles currently being shipped by Novartis are recommended for patients under 130 pounds. MMCAP's Novartis Vaccines representative has stated that Novartis Vaccines has stopped shipping the 5/8 inch Pre Filled Syringes and will exchange member's orders for the Luer-Lok syringe if necessary.

The CDC advises that "the presentation is licensed for use in persons aged 4 years and older, regardless of weight, and can be used that way if there is not other vaccine available as a substitute. Close attention to administration technique is critical if this presentation is used for a person weighing more than 130 pounds to assure that the vaccine is injected into the muscle and not into subcutaneous tissue."

OGS is working with MMCAP during this time to adequately protect the needs of NYS customers. OGS will continue to keep contract participants informed of related future developments.

SUMMARY OF POLICY AND PROHIBITIONS ON PROCUREMENT LOBBYING:

Pursuant to State Finance Law §§139-j and 139-k, this solicitation includes and imposes certain restrictions on communications between OGS and an Offerer/bidder during the procurement process. BACKGROUND AND INTENT:

In accordance with Article XI Section 163 of the New York State Finance Law, the Commissioner of General Services (hereinafter "OGS", "State" or "Purchaser"), may authorize purchases required by New York State agencies or other authorized purchasers by approving the use of a contract let by any department, agency or instrumentality of the United States government and/or any department, agency, office, political subdivision or instrumentality of any state or states. The OGS Procurement Services Group, on behalf of the Commissioner, finds it necessary and desirable to enter into a contract based on this Piggyback Agreement (hereinafter "New York State Contract") with Novartis Vaccines (hereinafter "Vendor" or "Contractor") for the purchase of specified products under the terms and conditions established pursuant to MMCAP Contract No. MMS28003 for Influenza Vaccine (hereinafter "Master Contract") by State agencies and other authorized purchasers. By completing and signing this document, Vendor is willing and able to enter into a contract and authorizes OGS to process the contract and provide notification to all authorized purchasers.

SHORT TERM EXTENSION:

In the event the replacement contract has not been issued, any contract let and awarded hereunder by the State, may be extended unilaterally by the State for an additional period of up to one month upon notice to the contractor with the same terms and conditions as the original contract including, but not limited to, quantities (prorated for such one month extension), prices, and delivery requirements. With the concurrence of the contractor, the extension may be for a period of up to three months in lieu of one month. However, this extension terminates should the replacement contract be issued in the interim.

CANCELLATION FOR CONVENIENCE:

The State of New York retains the right to cancel this contract, in whole or in part without reason provided that the Contractor is given at least sixty (60) days notice of its intent to cancel. This provision should not be understood as waiving the State's right to terminate the contract for cause or stop work immediately for unsatisfactory work, but is supplementary to that provision. Any such cancellation shall have no effect on existing Agency agreements, which are subject to the same 60 day discretionary cancellation or cancellation for cause by the respective user Agencies.

NON-STATE AGENCIES PARTICIPATION IN CENTRALIZED CONTRACTS:

New York State political subdivisions and others authorized by New York State law may participate in this contract. These include, but are not limited to local governments, public authorities, public school and fire districts, public and nonprofit libraries, and certain other nonpublic/nonprofit organizations. See "Participation in Centralized Contracts" in Appendix B, OGS General Specifications. For purchase orders issued by the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey (or any other authorized entity that may have delivery locations adjacent to New York State), the terms of the "Price" clause shall be modified to include delivery to locations adjacent to New York State.

Upon request, all eligible non-State agencies must furnish contractors with the proper tax exemption certificates and documentation certifying eligibility to use State contracts. EMERGENCY PURCHASING:

In the event that a disaster emergency is declared by Executive Order under Section 28 of Article 2-B of the Executive Law, or that the Commissioner determines pursuant to his/her authority under Section 163(10)(b) of the State Finance Law that an emergency exists requiring the prompt and immediate delivery of commodities or services, the Commissioner reserves the right to obtain such commodities or services from any source, including but not limited to this contract, as the Commissioner in his/her sole discretion determines will meet the needs of such emergency. Contractor shall not be entitled to any claim or lost profits for commodities or services procured from other sources pursuant to this paragraph.

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"OGS OR LESS" GUIDELINES APPLY TO THIS CONTRACT

Purchases of the products included in the Piggyback Agreement and related Contract Award Notification are subject to the "OGS or Less" provisions of Section 163.3.a.v., Article XI, of the New York State Finance Law. This means that State agencies can purchase products from sources other than the contractor provided that such products are substantially similar in form, function or utility to the products herein and are:

1. lower in price
-and/or-
2. available under terms which are more economically efficient to the State agency (e.g. delivery terms, warranty terms, etc.).

Agencies are reminded that they must provide the State contractor an opportunity to match the non-contract savings at least two business days prior to purchase. In addition, purchases made under "OGS or Less" flexibility must meet all requirements of law including, but not limited to, advertising in the New York State Contract Reporter, prior approval of the Comptroller's Office and competitive bidding of requirements exceeding the discretionary bid limit. State agencies should refer to Procurement Council Bulletin "OGS or Less Purchases" for complete procedural and reporting requirements.

DIESEL EMISSION REDUCTION ACT OF 2006 (NEW REQUIREMENT OF LAW):

On February 12, 2007 the Diesel Emissions Reduction Act took effect as law (the "Law"). Pursuant to new §19-0323 of the N.Y. Environmental Conservation Law ("NYECL") it is now a requirement that heavy duty diesel vehicles in excess of 8,500 pounds use the best available retrofit technology ("BART") and ultra low sulfur diesel fuel ("ULSD"). The requirement of the Law applies to all vehicles owned, operated by or on behalf of, or leased by State agencies and State or regional public authorities. They need to be operated exclusively on ULSD by February 12, 2007. It also requires that such vehicles owned, operated by or on behalf of, or leased by State agencies and State or regional public authorities with more than half of its governing body appointed by the Governor utilize BART.

As a contract vendor the Law may be applicable to vehicles used by contract vendors "on behalf of" State agencies and public authorities. Thirty-three percent (33%) of affected vehicles must have BART by December 31, 2008, sixty-six percent (66%) by December 31, 2009 and one-hundred percent (100%) by December 31, 2010. The Law provides a list of exempted vehicles. Regulations currently being drafted will provide further guidance as to the effects of the Law on contract vendors using heavy duty diesel vehicles on behalf of the State. The Law also permits waivers of ULSD and BART under limited circumstances at the discretion of the Commissioner of Environmental Conservation. The Law will also require reporting from State agencies and from contract vendors in affected contracts.

Therefore, the bidder hereby certifies and warrants that all heavy duty vehicles, as defined in NYECL §19-0323, to be used under this contract, will comply with the specifications and provisions of NYECL §19-0323, and any regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, which requires the use of BART and ULSD, unless specifically waived by NYSDEC. Qualification and application for a waiver under this Law will be the responsibility of the bidder.
