

## **1984 26' Motor Whale Boat MK 10**

You are bidding on a 26-foot Motor Whaleboat MK10 built for the United States Navy. It was intended to be used as a lifeboat, officer's boat, mail boat, or gig and is manned by a two-man crew.

The boat you are bidding on is structurally solid with no damage on the hull side or bottom but has not been run in several years. The boat is being represented as inoperable although the Westerbeke 25hp engine was run 18 months ago. The boat has a brand new starter valued at \$1,200 but needs wiring for the starter system. The boat also needs an exhaust system estimated at \$600 - \$1,200. There is no trailer, no cradle, no electronics and no accessories that go along with the boat.

A bill of sale will be provided but there is no title, registration or other proof of ownership.
