OGS TO AUCTION SEIZED 2007 LAMBORGHINI ON NOVEMBER 8 IN ALBANY

Seized BMW and Porsche Also Being Auctioned

The New York State Office of General Services (OGS) has added a 2007 Lamborghini Gallardo Nera two-door coupe to the list of items the public can bid on at a surplus vehicle, highway equipment, and miscellaneous property auction scheduled to start at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday, November 8 at the Harriman State Office Building Campus in Albany. Items being sold will be available for inspection starting at 8:30 a.m. on the day of the auction.

The Lamborghini was seized by the Attorney General's Office in 2013 following an investigation into a \$3.2 million Medicaid fraud case in Brooklyn. Proceeds from the sale of the car will be transferred to the Attorney General's Medicaid Fraud Unit. OGS previously auctioned a 2013 Mercedes G63, a 2012 Porsche Cayenne, and a 2012 Audi A7, which were also seized as part of the same Medicaid fraud investigation.

The Lamborghini has a black exterior with an engine hood that features a transparent glass panel. It has a 10-cylinder, 5.0-liter/303-cubic-inch, 493-horsepower aluminum engine with 6,316 miles on it and a six-speed, e-shift automatic transmission.

The November 8 auction will also feature two other luxury cars that were seized by the Department of Motor Vehicles after they were reported stolen in separate incidents: a 2012 BMW 650 convertible with approximately 35,924 miles on its odometer and a 1986 Porsche 911 Turbo Carrera will approximately 42,010 miles on it.
