### **OGS TO AUCTION TWO SEIZED LUXURY CARS AT NOVEMBER 8 VEHICLE AND EQUIPMENT AUCTION IN ALBANY**

The New York State Office of General Services has added a 2012 BMW 650 Convertible and a 1986 Porsche 911 Turbo Carrera to the list of items the public can bid on at a surplus vehicle, highway equipment, and miscellaneous property auction scheduled to start at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday, November 8 at the Harriman State Office Building Campus in Albany. Items being sold will be available for inspection starting at 8:30 a.m. on the day of the auction.

The BMW, with approximately 35,924 miles on its odometer, and the Porsche, with approximately 42,010 miles on it, were reported stolen and were recently seized by New York State Department of Motor Vehicles.

This isn't the first time OGS has sold seized items. In 2016, OGS sold a seized Maserati Gran Turismo and BMW X6 following an investigation into a \$3.2 million Medicaid fraud case in Brooklyn. In the summer of 2014, several pieces of men's jewelry and a Rolex were sold on the NYSStore.com eBay site after they were confiscated from a suspected drug trafficker on Staten Island.
