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**OGS TO AWARD OVER \$6.0 MILLION IN NEW CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS
Work to Commence in Nine New York Counties**

New York State Office of General Services Commissioner John C. Egan today announced the awarding of bids for 11 contracts representing more than \$6.0 MILLION in new construction, providing work in nine counties of New York.

The contracts are expected to be awarded to the apparent low bidders following the normal process of review and approval by the State Comptroller's Office. All of the low bidders are New York State firms.

The projects and apparent low bidders are described in the following listing by county:

BROOME COUNTY

An electrical contract to provide energy efficient lighting at the State Armory in Binghamton, NY was bid by seven firms. Of those seven, A. C. Spear Electric, Inc. of Binghamton, NY was the apparent low bidder with a bid of \$73,850.

CHEMUNG COUNTY

Construction and electrical contracts were bid to rehabilitate toilets, visit room administration Building No. 8 at the Elmira Correctional Facility in Elmira, NY.

Construction: Streeter Associates, Inc. of Elmira, NY was the apparent low bidder out of seven firms. The low bid was \$393,000.

Electrical: JB Daniel LLC of Geneva, NY was the apparent low bidder out of one firm. The low bid was \$47,300.

ERIE COUNTY

A construction contract to replace roofs Building Nos. 60, 62, 63, 64, 96, 97 & connecting corridors at the Collins Correctional Facility in Collins, NY was bid by four firms. Of those four, New Britain Roofing Co., Inc. of Horseheads, NY was the apparent low bidder with a bid of \$1,828,100.

MONROE COUNTY

A heating and ventilation contract to replace hvac at the Army Aviation Support Facility#2 in Rochester, NY was bid by four firms. Of those four, Postler & Jaeckle Corp. of Rochester, NY was the apparent low bidder with a bid of \$346,360.

ORANGE COUNTY

A construction contract to replace various doors Building Nos. 26, 105-115, 118 and 121-124 at the Otisville Correctional Facility in Otisville, NY was bid by three firms. Of those three, F.C. & C. Constr. Enterprises, Inc. of Highland Falls, NY was the apparent low bidder with a bid of \$989,000.

RICHMOND COUNTY

A heating and ventilation contract to replace hvac system in pool Building No. 26 at the Staten Island DDSO in Staten Island, NY was bid by six firms. Of those six, B.P. & J. Associates, Inc. of Huntington Station, NY was the apparent low bidder with a bid of \$335,000.

STEUBEN COUNTY

Electrical and heating and ventilation contracts were bid to replace boiler and accessory equipment at the State Armory in Hornell, NY.

Electrical: JB Daniel LLC of Geneva, NY was the apparent low bidder out of one firm. The low bid was \$23,400.

Heating and Ventilation: Unified Mechanical Contractor's, Inc. of Geneva, NY was the apparent low bidder out of nine firms. The low bid was \$209,600.

SUFFOLK COUNTY

A construction contract to rehabilitate tie down pads and replace blacktop at the Army Aviation Support Facility No 1 in Ronkonkoma, NY was bid by ten firms. Of those ten, Galvin Bros., Inc. of Great Neck, NY was the apparent low bidder with a bid of \$1,041,023.

WESTCHESTER COUNTY

A construction contract to replace roof of Building No. 15 at the Sing Sing Correctional Facility in Ossining, NY was bid by 11 firms. Of those 11, Monpat Construction Inc. of Flushing, NY was the apparent low bidder with a bid of \$784,000.
