Corcraft is the trade name of the Division of Correctional Industries of the New York State Department of Correctional Services. Under the Corcraft program, prison inmates manufacture a wide variety of goods for government use.



Industries has been a valuable part of New York's correctional program for nearly two hundred years. During most of the 1800's, inmate made goods were sold on the open market in competition with private sector goods. Beginning in the 1880's, however, New York adopted the current State Use system restricting the sale of inmate-made goods to public entities such as the correctional system itself, state and local government offices and institutions, and educational facilities.

A purchase from Corcraft is not only an investment in a quality product known for its durability. It is also an investment in the correctional system. Inmate employment in the productive Corcraft program teaches work skills and a work ethic to men and women who commonly enter prison with virtually no work history, enabling them to earn an honest living upon release and return to New York's communities. Corcraft also helps to offset the costs of incarceration, estimated at upwards of \$25,000 per inmate per year, to New York's taxpayers.
